Summer Camp Director – Provides leadership to all summer positions. Serves as liaison to the Program Director. Also responsible for staff morale and discipline. Helps insure that all staff duties are fulfilled, schedules are followed, and the program's mission is met.

Aquatics Coordinator – Provide leadership to lifeguards. Serves as the leader at pool. Provides a weekly curriculum and teaches swimming lessons.

Lifeguard Pool – Responsible for the pool and its activities, care, and supervision.

Lifeguard Boating – Daily responsibilities are leadership and maintenance of waterfront and boating areas that include canoeing and kayaking.

Outdoor Education Coordinator – Provide leadership to programs under this area, expected to lead programs if called upon. Areas of responsibility are Shooting Sports, Nature & Ecology, and Arts. Coordinator should also be able or willing to be trained in Team Challenge Course.

Ecology/Nature Coordinator – Utilize Wet Lab and environment to teach activities that show importance of environment, also maintain animals and materials in the Wet Lab.

Outdoor Living Skills Specialist – Teaches basic survival skills, leads hikes, initiate geocaching and orienteering, provides camping leadership. Also teaches first aid.

Arts Leader – Leads arts and crafts programs, drama, and initiates campfire singing.

Adventure Coordinator – Provides leadership to all outdoor adventure areas – main duties at ropes courses. Adheres to and initiates a weekly curriculum.

High/Low Ropes Facilitator (2) – Provide leadership at low ropes, climbing wall and the high combined courses. Facilitators will also lead teambuilding exercises.

Shooting Sports Specialist – Provide leadership in archery and riflery – must be or become 4-H certified.

Sports and Games Leader – Provide leadership to both small and large scale sporting events.

Male Head Counselor – Serves as assistant at program rotations, also manages all male counselor/camper relations.

Female Head Counselor – Serves as an assistant at program rotations, also manages all female counselor/camper relations.

Male Cabin Counselors (6) – Responsible for daily care and supervision of male campers.

Female Cabin Counselors (6) – Responsible for daily care and supervision of female campers.

Day Camp Coordinator – Provides curriculum and implementation of day camp activities. Serves as group leader in program areas.

Day Camp Counselor – Assists Day Camp Coordinator in providing quality care and supervision of campers.
